For the health and safety of our canine companions we require proof of the following **CORE** ★ vaccinations prior to participating in classes, events and activities. In addition to the core vaccines we also require all dogs to receive the **BORDETELLA VACCINE** ★

Exceptions will be made if your dog has been deemed at risk by your veterinarian for any vaccine. We will also accept a titers in place of the vaccines.
