



Special Considerations

Your pet's safety and comfort are a priority during every grooming experience. Occasionally, grooming can expose hidden medical problems, or potentially aggravate a current condition. This can occur during or after grooming.

Special considerations may also include the following:

- Geriatric Pets** – We will do our very best to complete your senior dog's groom quickly. Sometimes senior dogs need breaks to keep them comfortable. We will work within your pet's limitations to provide as thorough of a service as possible. Also, grooming can be stressful for your pet at this age. We are not responsible for injury or sudden death of your pet.
- Cat Grooming** – When cats are exposed to a new environment, they can experience elevated stress levels. If your cat is too stress to safely continue the groom, all activities will stop, and you will be immediately notified. Grooming can also expose or aggravate a hidden medical problem. Finally, shaving mats or normal grooming can be dangerous since cats have thin skin that may tear even with gentle handling.
- Fur coloring** – Fur coloring is an additional service offered to our clients. Colors can last up to 100 washes. We only use pet-friendly products; however, we are not responsible for any skin irritation, allergic reactions, or the transfer of dye to other surfaces.

In the best interest of your pet, we request your permission to obtain immediate veterinary treatment should it become necessary.
